We want to see God's blessing fall and remain on Vanuatu - and this is only possible when it can manifest through people touched by His nature.

### Short Term Missions Trip - July 2006

A team of our youth and leaders went over to work with and support the church in Vanuatu. The team travelled from Port Vila, up to Santo meeting with church leaders and youth alike, before returning again to Port Vila Apostolic Church to minister there also.
